Dear Residents, Family Members and Resident Representatives,

Yesterday afternoon, we were made aware of upcoming significant developments that we expect to favorably impact our visitation guidelines. The NJ Department of Health will be releasing visitation guidance for the upcoming Passover and Easter holidays early next week. In addition, they will provide a more general visitation supplement to earlier guidance. This guidance is expected to be very similar to the CMS guidance issued on March 11, 2021. After the visitation information is issued, the NJ Department of Health will work to completely redo the current executive directive and will be issuing separate directives for nursing homes and assisted living communities. We are very excited about these updates, and we will share information with you as we receive it.

Please see the schedules below for our three neighborhoods. We had one Assisted Living staff member and two Skilled Nursing staff members test positive for COVID-19 this week, so unfortunately the reopening dates have been further delayed. However, if the anticipated revised guidance is very similar to the CMS guidance as expected, the factors that determine the reopening schedule outlined below should change significantly.
